■ What is C-TPAT

After 9/11, United Stated of America and US Customs and Border Protection (CBP) started to be concerned with possibility of terrorists using a global supply chain to turn cargo container shipment into weapons via import/export operation.

C-TPAT is a joint US government and business voluntary program to construct supportive relationships that strengthen the global supply chain and border security by improving security in regards to transportation of goods, cargo, and persons during the course of the commercial shipping process. It also seeks to safeguard the world's vibrant trade industry from terrorists, maintaining the economic health of the U.S. and its neighbors.

Companies who are seeking to be C-TPAT compliant must have a documented process for determining and alleviating risk throughout their international supply chain. This allows companies to be considered low risk, resulting in expedited processing of their cargo, including fewer Customs examinations.

Examples of the areas for which US Customs provides recommendations are:

Procedural Security

Procedures for the movement of goods to protect against shipments being tampered with or unmanifested goods being introduces into the supply chain.

Physical Security

Construction and material make up of buildings, entrance security, lighting, etc., for purposes of preventing unlawful entry.

Access Control

Procedures to prevent unauthorized access to facilities and conveyances

Personnel Security

Employment screening and background checks, and disciplinary measures for personnel that breach

• Education and Training

A program to train employees regarding security awareness, cargo integrity, and procedures for reporting discrepancies.

Manifest Procedures

Procedures to ensure manifest accuracy and timeliness.

Conveyance Security

Conveyance integrity to protect against unauthorized personnel, unmanifested materials, or tampering.
